Format: All players entered are guaranteed a minimum of 7 matches.

Week 1-2: Box League prelims - self-scheduling

All players are seeded by the squash committee and entered into groups of 4 players (top 4 in Group A, next 4 in Group B, etc.). Each week the 4 players must complete their round robin, with each box being assigned a day of the week to play their matches. At the end of week 1, the top from each group will advance to the higher group, while the bottom from each group will be demoted. Scoring is one point per game, best of 5 games. Players are responsible for recording the score of each match on the box league sheets posted on the squash notice board.

Week 3: Main Draw – preliminaries

Players will be entered in draws of 8 players each (top 8 in the A Draw, 9-16 in the B Draw, etc.)

Week 4: Quarters and Semis

Matches will be scheduled on fixed days such that members can come out to spectate; Quarter Finals November 21 - 24; Semi Finals on Friday 25th November.

Week 5: FINALS

On Friday 2nd December all the 3rd/4th and FINALS for each draw will be played.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Rules of Squash as laid down by the World Squash Federation and as amended **May 1, 2001** shall apply to this tournament. The T.T.S.A. Code of Conduct shall also be upheld during the tournament.
2. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to **Q.P.C.C. members** and T & T residents only.
3. The Dunlop Pro Double Yellow Dot Ball shall be the official ball of the tournament.
4. Entries for all players close on **Monday 24th October, 2011.** Completed entry forms accompanied by the applicable entrance fee shall be submitted to QPCC Office or, if permitted by tournament committee, directly to the Tournament Committee. Entry via e-mail will be accepted BUT entry fee should be paid to office and receipt collected.
5. **Format:** See entry form.
6. **Players will be expected to mark and referee the match following their own. If for any reasons the players cannot do so, they are responsible for finding a competent referee and marker to act on their behalf. Players are also expected to wear proper squash attire.**
7. The draw will be made after the close of acceptance of entries and will be posted on the notice board of the Q.P.C.C. Squash Club by Friday October 28, 2011.
8. This tournament is under the control of the QPCC **Tournament Committee**, and this Committee shall deal with all disputes.
9. Players who enter this tournament do so entirely at their own risk and the QPCC Squash Club and/or the QPCC Tournament Committee will not accept responsibility for any injury or disability arising from participation in the tournament (See rule 11 – QPCC Waiver). **All JUNIOR players must wear eye protection while participating in this event.**
10. QPCC Waiver:
 - a. I recognize the possibility of physical injury associated with squash, and voluntarily accept and assume this risk as part of my playing squash for the above-named squash organization.
 - b. I hereby release, discharge, and otherwise indemnify the Queen's Park Cricket Club (QPCC), their sponsors and its affiliated organizations, the squash facility, and the employees and associated personnel of these organizations, against any claim by or on my behalf, as a result of my participation in QPCC's Member tournament.
 - c. I also understand and accept that registration in QPCC's Member tournament does not include primary or secondary accident or medical insurance. I understand that if I am a member of QPCC in good financial standing, registration in QPCC's Member tournament does provide me the same liability insurance coverage afforded all other members of QPCC.
